Entrance Requirements

Deficiency: Programs leading to teacher certification are exempted from the science deficiency requirement.

Teacher Education Admission Requirements

Before taking more than 6 hours of any combination of EACH, EDUC, READ, or SPED courses students must be admitted to the Teacher Education Program. Admission requirements are:

1. Have health and physical clearance from the university doctor or nurse;
2. Completed 60 or more approved hours;
3. Have approval by the Dean of Students;
4. Have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.70;
5. Successfully pass all sections of the TASP with a score of 260 or higher on the reading section;
6. Complete a test on critical thinking skills with a satisfactory score;
7. Complete and submit an application for admission to the Teacher Education Admissions Committee;
8. Have a grade of C or above in 9 hours of English;
9. Submit satisfactory recommendations from 3 faculty members;
10. Complete an interview with the Teacher Education Admissions Committee;
11. Receive approval of the Teacher Education Admissions Committee.

Electives

6 hours, 3 which may be advanced Bible; 3 of which may be from deficiency. May *not* include Academic Advance courses. Arrange to ensure ≥33 advanced hours.
