

Faculty Scholarship Award

College of Arts and Sciences

The CAS Faculty Scholarship Award will provide a faculty member with three hours of reassigned time for reflection, writing and other types of scholarly activity. In addition, the faculty member will receive up to \$500 for travel, books, or supplies related to the activity.

Eligibility and Application

Any full-time faculty member in a department of the College of Arts and Sciences is eligible to apply for the award. Reassigned time for scholarly activity in the last 3 years will be taken into consideration.

The application should include the following information:

- * Name
- * Department
- * Rank
- * Years of service at ACU
- * Description of proposed activity (500-600 words)
 - Purpose
 - Procedures
 - Product(s)
- * Budget for funds requested (up to \$500)
- * Listing of reassigned time for scholarly activity in the last three years
- * Value of activity to the applicant professionally, the applicant's discipline, ACU students and/or the University
- * Statement of how this activity fits the idea of Christian Scholarship

A current curriculum vita should be included with the application. The applicant should request that the department chair send a confidential letter to the Dean with his/her review of the proposed activity, as well as a statement concerning how the reassigned time will be covered.

At least two awards will be given that relate to the Scholarship of Teaching, if applications meeting the criteria are received.

All applications are due to the Dean's office by the last Friday in September. Applicants who are chosen for the award will be notified by the end of October. A short report giving the results of the activity will be due in the Dean's office by the first Monday in August of the following year.
