These scholarships will be awarded based on both scholastic aptitude and community involvement. Scholastic aptitude should be evidenced by high scores on ACT or SAT examinations, plus a substantial high school grade point average.

Once a scholarship is granted, it will continue throughout a student's undergraduate program, provided that a cumulative GPA of at least 3.25 is maintained and that the student remains a COBA major. Awards are typically for \$500 per long semester.

To apply for a College of Business Administration Scholarship, provide the following:

- Completed application form (attached)
- A letter describing your academic accomplishments and achievements
- Two letters of recommendation from teachers, friends, etc. that are well acquainted with you.
