1. Plan schedules carefully, so as to fulfill all pre-requisites for the next semester's courses. Approval of pre-requisite waivers will be granted only under *extreme* circumstances.
2. Check with your academic advisor before changing the sequence of courses since some are not offered every semester.
3. Check your account early to allow time to eliminate any hold that might prevent pre-registration.
4. Pre-register early to secure prime time slots for your classes.
