A. Intercollege Students (Hardin-Simmons University, McMurry University):

A properly signed Intercollege permit from your home school.

- B. High School Students:** A letter of permission from your high school counselor or principal and a transcript of work completed to-date. Local high school students from surrounding towns can take college work concurrent with their high school courses provided such an arrangement is approved by an official of the high school. The student must have completed their junior year of high school as a minimum and have a statement that they are (1) ranked in the upper three-fourths of the class, or (2) have an average of 85 or higher on work completed to-date.
