HIST 221 American History I

Survey of cultural, economic and political dimensions of America from the early explorations to 1877.

Texas Common Course Number HIST 1301

AENV 130 Environmental and Technological Science

A study of environmental and technological sciences including natural resources and the impact of modern technology on the human environment.

For non-science majors.

Texas Common Course Number BIOL 2306

MATH 120 Quantitative Reasoning

Statistics and data analysis, mathematics of finance, probability, and function models. Problem solving and technology intensive. Preferred score minimums of 20 ACT/500 SAT for math/quantitative.

Texas Common Course Number MATH 1332

ENGL 111 Composition and Rhetoric

The theory and practice in reading and writing analytical and persuasive essays. Preferred score minimums of 19 ACT/500 SAT for English/verbal including the writing placement test.

Texas Common Course Number ENGL 1301

SPAN 111 Elementary Spanish I

Introduction to the Spanish language; Emphasis on oral communication skills. Preferred score minimums of 19 ACT/460 SAT for English/verbal.

Requires department approval.

A conceptual investigation of biological principles from the human perspective - including historical, theoretical, ethical, and practical aspects.
