

# CREDENTIALING FOR TEACHERS AT PROSPECTIVE PRIVATE SCHOOLS

## PROGRAM STRENGTHS

- We have carefully selected a limited number of dual credit courses that would appeal to a broad set of students and would be transferable.
- These courses have been developed by Christian faculty who understand the importance of integrating faith and learning.
- By offering a few courses, we can better ensure academic rigor and provide an authentic college-level experience.
- We believe that dual credit should support students who desire advanced learning and thinking, but it should not replace a student's high school curriculum.

## OPTION 1

For a teacher who is credentialed to teach a dual credit course, ACU will provide the following:

- A document that describes the course, the goals of the course, etc.
- A sample syllabus for the course that contains the learning outcomes and objectives and suggested schedule
- Sample assessments (tests, quizzes, homework, discussions, etc.)
- Access to and use of Canvas for the section of the course and the ability to make changes
- Supplemental instructional materials
- Instructional support from the academic department

## OPTION 2

For a teacher who will be supervised but will teach a dual credit course, ACU will provide the following:

- A document that describes the course, the goals of the course, etc.
- The course syllabus that contains the learning outcomes and objectives and due dates for tests and other assignments
- The assessments for the course (tests, quizzes, homework, discussions, etc.)
- Access to and use of Canvas for the section of the course but no ability to modify
- Supplemental instructional materials
- Instructional support and supervision from a faculty member in the academic department
