PROGRAM FEATURES

- Transportation between Abilene and Oxford (return to DFW).
- Planned class-related field trips (trips in the past have been to London, Paris/Normandy, Stonehenge, Warwick Castle, Canterbury, Whitby, Bath and Dover).
- International service-learning opportunities include work with local churches.
- Great location in fashionable North Oxford. Local shops and a first-rate market are nearby.
- Student housing at 9 and 10 Canterbury Road includes dorm rooms, bathrooms, kitchen, computer lab and laundry facilities.
- Some long weekends and a week-long fall break for personal travel. An additional opportunity for personal travel at the conclusion of the program is also available.
- Medical and travelers' insurance included.

APPLICATION

Acceptance to the ACU in Oxford program is based on a variety of factors including:

- Completed application packet with satisfactory reference forms.
- Availability of space.
- \$100 application fee.
- Completion of at least 30 credit hours on campus.
- Academic record and interests, a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5 as of date of application.
- Students must be in good standing with ACU (no probation of any kind) as of date of application.

Note: Consideration will also be given to a student's suitability for participation in an ACU Study Abroad Program.
