The Cost

Tuition and fees are the same in this summer program as they would be in Abilene (can be included in 2015-2016 block). The additional program fee of \$6,700 includes:

- Transportation between DFW and program sites in England, Spain, and Ghana.
- Housing in program sites and on group excursions.
- Program-related field trips and enrichment activities.
- Most meals during the Ghana portion (meals in England and Spain are not included)
- Basic medical and travelers' insurance.

Please note this program fee does not include the Ghanaian visa fee, nor does it include recommended and required immunizations for travel to Ghana.

Application

Acceptance to this ACU Study Abroad program is based on a variety of factors including:

- Completed application packet with satisfactory reference forms.
- Availability of space.
- \$250 non-refundable application fee.
- Completion of at least two semesters on campus.
- A minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5 as of date of application and up to date of departure.
- Students must be in good standing with ACU (no probation of any kind) as of date of application and up to date of departure.
- Priority will be given to students who are in the JUST degree plan through the Honors College and then to other Honors students. Please see the application periods below.

Note: Consideration also will be given to a student's suitability for participation in a study abroad program.

Application Deadlines

Sept. 1 – Dec. 5: Limited to students who are enrolled in the JUST degree plan through the Honors College.

Dec. 6 – Feb. 6: Open to all other Honors students.
