

## Windows Service Pack 2

- Affects users of Windows XP Professional or Home Edition
- Pop-up blocker causes problems with sending mail with Webmail
- Faculty/Staff computers are automatically updated and are not affected

### Disabling pop-up blocker for myACU/Webmail:

a. Built-in pop-up blocking is automatically turned on by default.

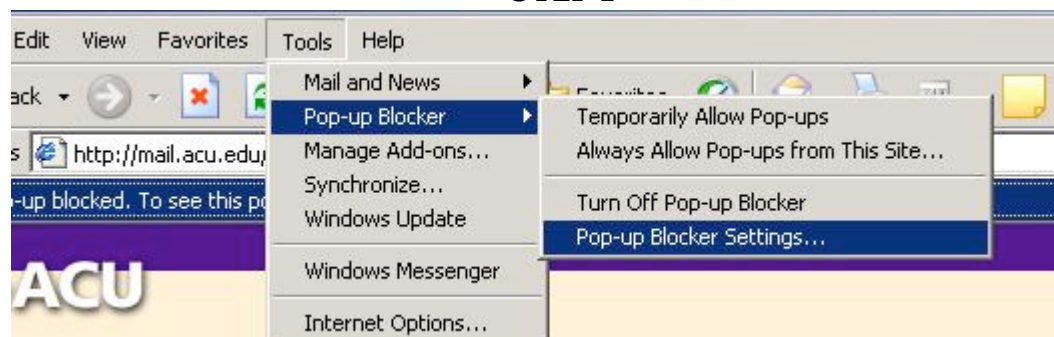

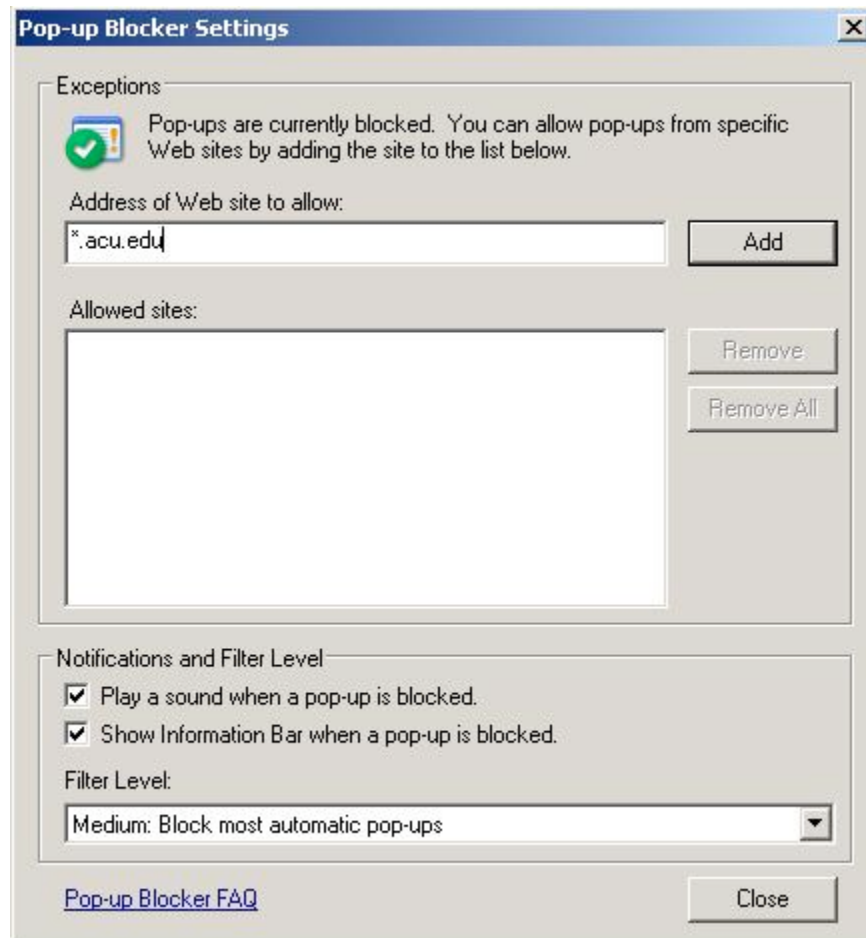


c. To allow pop-ups from all ACU websites refer to the two steps below.
