

Ethernet Configurations

Macintosh

This page gives instructions for installing, configuring, and using an Ethernet connection for Macintosh.

Setting Up Your Connection.

- A. Click the *Apple* menu, scroll down to *Control Panel* and open *AppleTalk*.
- B. The dialog box on the left (Fig. 12) will open.
- C. For *Connect via*, choose *Ethernet*. For *Current zone*, choose the name of your residence hall.
- D. Close *AppleTalk* and save the changes you made to your configuration.
- E. Click the *Apple* menu, scroll down to *Control Panel* and open *TCP/IP*.
- F. The dialog box on the left (Fig. 13) will open.
- G. For *Connect via* choose *Ethernet*. For *Configure*, choose *Using DHCP Server*. For *Search domains*, enter *acu.edu*.
- H. Close the *TCP/IP* menu.

You have completed the setup process for ResNet.
There is no need to restart your computer.
