

# Ethernet Configurations

## Macintosh OS X

### 1. Setting up a new location

- A. Open **System Preferences** from the Apple menu.
- B. Choose **Network** from the top.
- C. Click the **Location** menu and choose **New Location**.
- D. Name your new location "ACU Network".
- E. Click **OK**.

### 2. Configuring your Network Card

- A. Click the **Configure** menu and select the **Advanced** option.
- B. Make sure only the Ethernet option has a check next to it in the "On" column
- C. Click the **Configure** menu again and select the **Ethernet** option.
- D. Click the **TCP/IP** tab.
- E. Select **Using DHCP** in the **Configure Menu**.
- F. Leave all the "optional" spaces blank; all necessary information will be provided automatically.
- G. Click the **AppleTalk** tab.
- H. Select the checkbox to make AppleTalk Active.
- I. Leave everything blank under the **Proxies** Tab.
- J. Click the **Save** button to save your new configuration.

### 3. Connecting to the ACU Network

- A. Click the apple menu in the upper left of your screen and move your pointer over (don't click) **Location**. Choose the location you set up for ACU Network.
- B. Make sure your ethernet cable is securely plugged in at the wall and your computer.
