

How Does It Work?

1

Complete the Online Application

It's simple! The administrator of the camp should go to the URMIA Youth Camps Insurance Program website and click **BUY ONLINE**. There is a one-page online application.

2

Provide Certificate to Institution

After the camp receives a copy of the sports camp insurance coverage and an "additional insured" certificate naming the college or university on the policy, the camp administrator should provide a copy of the certificate to the institution's risk management office.

The URMIA Youth Camps Insurance Program provides excellent liability insurance for youth camps using college and university facilities. The college or university receives an "additional insured" certificate naming it as an additional insured on the camp's policy.



Coverage Overview

The policy includes general liability, accident, and sexual abuse/molestation coverage. There are no deductibles. For details, go to the URMIA Youth Camps Insurance Program website and click on **POLICY LIMITS AND COVERAGE**.
